## BOARD POLICY

---

### BP 3540 – Sexual and Other Assaults on Campus

---

*Reference: Education Code Section 67385*

Any sexual assault or physical abuse, including rape as defined by California law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public, which occurs on District property, is a violation of District policies and procedures, and is subject to all applicable punishment, including criminal procedures and employee or student discipline procedures. Students, faculty, and staff who may be victims of sexual and other assaults shall be treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance. The Superintendent/President or designee shall establish administrative procedures that ensure that students, faculty, and staff who are victims of sexual and other assaults receive appropriate information and treatment.

The procedures for sexual assaults shall meet the criteria contained in EC 67385 and shall include assurances that all victims of sexual assault on District property shall be provided with information regarding options and assistance available to them.

The District shall protect the identity of any alleged victim of sexual assault on District property unless the alleged victim specifically waives that right to confidentiality. The District shall maintain the identity of any alleged assailant who is a student or an employee in confidence unless the alleged assailant waives that right to confidentiality.
