Electronic Resources

Research Databases (Library homepage <http://www.butte.edu/library> → For articles)

EBSCO Greenfile

A collection of scholarly, government and general-interest titles which includes content on global warming, green building, pollution, sustainable agriculture, renewable energy, recycling, and more. The database provides indexing and abstracts for more than 384,000 records, as well as Open Access full text for more than 4,700 records.

EBSCO Academic Search Premier

Full text for nearly 4,500 journals, including full text for more than 3,600 peer-reviewed titles. PDF backfiles to 1975 or further are available for well over one hundred journals, and searchable cited references are provided for 1,000 titles.

Proquest (multiple databases that cover many subject areas)

- Choose the appropriate search field (e.g. citation and abstract) and set the limit (e.g. limit result to full-text documents and/or scholarly journals)
